

Jenolan Caves

Regarded as Australia's most outstanding cave system, Jenolan Caves is among the finest and oldest cave systems in the world. Its network is enormous with cave passage estimated at over 40kms in length!

Highlights Include:

BLUE MOUNTAINS: Cross Australia's Great Dividing Range through this world heritage listed national park. See **THE THREE SISTERS** and **GOVETTS LEAP** lookout for incredible views of the canyons and waterfalls. **KANANGRA – BOYD NATIONAL PARK:** drop down into a deep gorge on a winding, narrow mountain road and drive through the caves to the village of Jenolan. **WILD KANGAROOS AND WALLABIES:** See these wonderful Australian animals up close in a natural bush setting. **JENOLAN CAVES:** lunch in this small, isolated village followed by a specialised, guided tour through the formations inside one of the amazing, natural caves.
