

Intermediate Canyoning

Tigersnake Canyon is definitely one not one to miss. The numerous waterfalls, abseils and short scrambles make for an awesome day of adventure. Three relatively easy abseils up to 17m in height are encountered as well as a spectacular narrow dark section. The canyon contains several shallow pools and small waterfalls which are negotiated by climbing or abseiling.

IMPORTANT: You MUST be able to abseil – have previous experience or completed a training course. Above average fitness is required for this trip.
