At the north-eastern most extreme of Sydney lies a rocky headland known as Barrenjoey, surrounded almost entirely by water. The sandstone cliffs of Barrenjoey offer some excellent climbing. Multi-pitch Abseil

Between the lush rainforests of the Jamison Valley and the aqua skies of the Blue Mountains lies a sweeping expanse of verticality called Malaita Walls. This fantastic abseil route runs straight down a 200 metre cliff face in five exciting stages. From the many unique vantage points and comfortable belay ledges there are breathtaking views of the Three Sisters and other towering sandstone ramparts. We will have lunch in a spacious sheltered cave, which provides a delightful diversion from the excitement of the abseiling. Experience your final thrill for the day as you are whisked upwards on the world's steepest railway (optional).
